



MARMOLEUM FLOORING

Marmoleum is an ecologically produced natural linoleum product that comes in different formats in a wide variety of color choices. The main ingredient is natural linseed oil produced by pressing the seeds from the flax plant. Pine rosins are combined with the linseed oil to produce a flexible binder mixed with wood flour. Only ecologically friendly pigments are used to create the beautiful range of colors. The backing is made from yarn spun from a strong jute fiber that grows plentifully in India and Bangladesh. The Marmoleum glueless “click” format has a top layer of natural Marmoleum, a middle layer of high density fiberboard with a natural cork bottom layer for comfort underfoot. This format allows for do-it-yourself installation and is ideal for high traffic areas and over radiant heat. It is easily installed and maintained and is available in 12" x 36" panels and 12" x 12" squares. These tiles can be mixed and matched to create dramatic and unique patterns. Marmoleum is durable enough for our own Echo Museum on the Burlington waterfront. Marmoleum Click can be installed on any clean, dry, structurally sound subfloor and is ideal flooring for living areas such as family rooms, kitchens & dining areas, bedrooms, etc.

Beautiful and Versatile:	Marmoleum offers unlimited design and pattern opportunities in both sheet and "Clic" formats in over 100 colors.
Durable:	Marmoleum is remarkably resistant to wear and used widely in commercial applications. It will actually continue to harden and become more durable over time
Environmental:	Marmoleum is made almost entirely from natural renewable plant-based resources and has no adverse health issues whatsoever, either during production, their useful lives, or disposal.
Hypoallergenic:	Marmoleum does not absorb dust and consequently does not cause allergies.
Anti-Static:	Marmoleum's anti-static properties reduces the potential for "electric shock", and makes the floor easier to clean in that dust and dirt will not easily adhere to the floor.
Healthy:	The bactericidal properties of linoleum prevent micro-organisms including Salmonella and Staphylococcus from multiplying themselves.
